Dennis Borland is a well-known local goalie that was critically injured in July of 2019 when he was struck by an uninsured motorist while riding his motorcycle home from an early morning skate. Dennis suffered many injuries as a result of the accident, including a severe leg injury that required below the knee amputation of his left leg. As he was healing, a bone infection developed and required further surgical intervention. Dennis was unable to move his knee for a long period of time which left him with stiff tendons, a problematic condition for long-term amputee recovery.

As a previous FCPHA beneficiary, Dennis is in need of further assistance to help him pay for an articulating prosthetic leg. This device has the potential to help him achieve a more complete range of motion and thereby decrease his everyday pain and discomfort.

While Dennis remains a tremendous optimist, the rising cost of ongoing needed medical care and his inability to work are difficult obstacles to overcome. FCPHA's help is needed to financially support this skater and his family that have been through so much. Despite it all, he remains hopeful to one day regain the ability to play in net.
